### **Angel Program Committee**

- The Angel Program is a program during the Holidays to help families that are in need.
- The Angel Program Committee is in need of volunteers to help distribute gifts.

### **Book Fair Committee**

- The Book Fair committee is responsible for implementing the Book Fair project in the fall that will sell books to raise money for the library.
